2023 Vitality Grant Application **Due October 28, 2022**

The Congregations Commission invites you to apply for a 2023 Vitality Grant. Similar to last year, all congregations are eligible to apply. Congregations may qualify based on the information provided in this application, and grant funds available. Priority is given to churches with demonstrated financial need. A commitment to attend the College for Congregational Development is a pre-requisite for receiving a grant.

In order to be considered, applications must be received by 5 pm on October 28, 2022. Late applications will not be considered.

- Submissions may be made electronically (emailed to Louisa McKellaston, lmckellaston@episcopalchicago.org) or sent by USPS to her attention at 65 E. Huron, Chicago, IL 60611.
- Louisa will confirm receipt of all applications to the sender by email.
- Given recent delays with the postal system, email submission is strongly encouraged.
- For mailed applications, we strongly suggest applications be postmarked by <u>October 14th, 2022</u>, to ensure receipt by the October 28 deadline.
- Funding decisions are expected by November 18, 2022.
